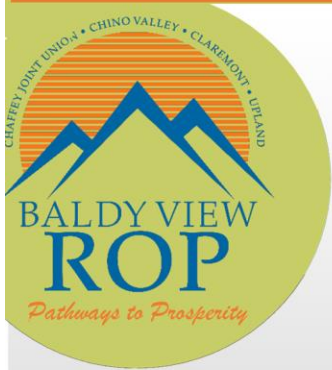

VOCATIONAL NURSING (Clock Hours 1530*) The Vocational Nursing program is a 17-month program designed to provide students with the basic knowledge, skills, and abilities to perform the duties of a Vocational Nurse in a health care environment. The practice of a vocational nurse is under the direction of a licensed physician or registered professional nurse. The program is approved by the Board of Vocational Nursing and Psychiatric Technicians and accredited by COE (Council on Occupational Education). The completion of this program meets the minimum requirements necessary for application to take the National Council Licensure Examination-Practical Nurse (NCLEX-PN)
